Sealed bids are hereby invited by the undersigned on behalf of the Punatsangchhu-II Hydroelectric Project Authority (PHPA-II), Wangdue, Bhutan, for the work “Rewinding of Water-Cooling Pump,” in accordance with the terms and conditions detailed below



Terms & Conditions:

1. **Scope of Work:** The scope of work shall comprise rewinding of one no. water-cooling pump. All spares required for the work shall be within the Contractor's scope. Transportation of the motor shall be within PPHA-II's scope.'

2. Specifications of the Work & Workmanship:

2.1 The motor rewinding shall be carried out strictly in accordance with the original equipment manufacturer's (OEM's) specifications, the latest applicable IS/IEC standards, and accepted industry practices. The original winding design and electrical characteristics—including conductor material and size, number of turns, coil pitch, winding connection, slot configuration, and insulation class—shall be maintained.

2.2 No alteration or deviation from the original design shall be permitted without the prior written approval of PPHA-II. All work shall be executed using suitable materials and high-quality workmanship.

3. **Price:** The rates quoted shall be FIRM AND FIXED for the work and inclusive of all taxes and duties.

4. **Price Schedule & Specification:** The applicable price schedule and specification are provided in Annex-I.

5. **Taxes:** TDS at 2% (two percent) shall be deducted from the bills of Bhutanese firms, and at 5% (five percent) from the bills of firms outside Bhutan.

6. **Bid Validity:** The offers shall remain valid for 60 days from the last date for submission of bids.

7. Bid Security/Earnest Money:

7.1 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amounting to **Nu/INR 8,000.00 (Nu/INR Eight Thousand only)**, in any of the forms stipulated below, shall be submitted along with the bid:

- i. Demand Draft in favour of the Punatsangchhu-II Hydroelectric Project Authority, Wangdue, Bhutan.
- ii. Bank Guarantee in favour of the Punatsangchhu-II Hydroelectric Project Authority, Wangdue, Bhutan as per the format attached at Annex-II.
- iii. Cash deposit into Account No. 102081338 with Bank of Bhutan (BOB) or Account No. 32379019627 with SBI, Jaigaon, India.
- iv. Online fund transfer to either of the accounts specified at Sl. No. iii above.

7.2 The EMD in the form of a Bank Guarantee shall remain valid for 90 (ninety) days from the last date for submission of bids.

7.3 The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be released after execution of the Contract Agreement with the successful bidder. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be released after submission of acceptable Performance Security in accordance with Clause 10 below. The EMD shall be returned without interest.

7.4 The EMD shall be liable to forfeiture if:

- i. The bid is withdrawn during its validity period after opening of the bids.
- ii. The bidder does not accept the correction of the Bid Price.
- iii. The successful bidder fails to furnish the Performance Security within the specified time limit.
- iv. The successful bidder fails to acknowledge receipt of and comply with the Job Order.



8. Submission & Opening of Bids:

- 8.1** The bids shall be submitted by post or hand delivery to the Office of the Chief Engineer, Block E-4, Bjimthangkha, latest by 1000 AM (BST) on **04.09.2026**, and shall be opened at 1030 AM (BST) on the same day.
- 8.2** The sealed outer envelope containing the quotation shall clearly bear **the date of opening and query no.** on the top/outside and shall be marked "Confidential." The sealed inner envelope containing the EMD and original bid shall be marked "**Original**" and shall bear the company's address.

9. Right to Accept or Reject Any or All Bids: PHPA-II reserves the right to reject any or all quotations without assigning any reason.

10. Performance Security & Agreement:

- 10.1** Within 7 (seven) days from placement of the Job Order, the successful bidder shall return a duly signed copy of the Job Order as a token of acceptance of all terms and conditions of the Contract. The Job Order shall serve as the formal Contract Agreement between PHPA-II and the Contractor.
- 10.2** Within 15 (fifteen) days from placement of the Job Order by PHPA-II, the successful bidder shall furnish the Performance Security @ 10% of the Contract Price, in any of the forms stipulated below:
- i. Demand Draft in favour of the Punatsangchhu-II Hydroelectric Project Authority, Wangdue, Bhutan.
 - ii. Bank Guarantee in favour of the Punatsangchhu-II Hydroelectric Project Authority, Wangdue, Bhutan as per the format provided in Annex-III.
 - iii. Cash deposit into Account No. 102081338 with Bank of Bhutan (BOB) or Account No. 32379019627 with SBI, Jaigaon, India.
 - iv. Online fund transfer to either of the accounts specified at Sl. No. iii above.
- 10.3** Performance Security furnished in the form of a Bank Guarantee shall remain valid until 30 days after expiry of the warranty period.
- 10.4** The Performance Security shall be retained by PHPA-II until expiry of the warranty period and shall be returned within 30 days thereafter.

11. Correction of Bid Prices:

- 11.1** Arithmetical errors in substantially responsive bids shall be corrected by PHPA-II as follows:
- i. Where there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the line-item obtained by multiplying the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate shall prevail and the line-item total shall be corrected.
 - ii. Where there is a discrepancy between the amount stated in figures and the amount stated in words, the amount stated in words shall prevail, unless it is related to an arithmetical error, in which case the amount stated in figures shall prevail, subject to Clauses 11.1 (i) above.
- 11.2** The corrected Bid Price shall be communicated to the bidder and shall be binding upon the bidder. If the bidder does not accept the correction of the Bid Price, its bid shall be rejected and the Earnest Money Deposit shall be forfeited.



12. **Contract Period:** The work shall be completed within 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue of the Job Order.
13. **Warranty Period:** The Contractor shall provide a warranty for the rewound motor for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of successful testing, commissioning and acceptance by PHPA-II.
14. **Liquidated Damages:** If the successful bidder fails to complete the work within the specified Contract Period, liquidated damages at 0.1% (zero point one percent) of the Job Order value per day of delay, subject to a maximum of 10% (ten percent) of the Job Order value, shall be levied.
15. **Payment:** 100% (one hundred percent) payment shall be released within 30 days after successful completion of the rewinding work.
16. **Pre-Contract Integrity Pact:** In accordance with the applicable ACC requirements and SBD provisions, the Bidder shall duly complete, sign and submit the prescribed Pre-Contract Integrity Pact (IP) with the Bid, failing which the Bid shall be rejected as non-responsive.

NOW THEREFORE we hereby affirm that we are the Guarantor and responsible to you, on behalf of the Contractor, upto a total of Nu/ INR _____ (Amount of Guarantee) (in words to be inserted by the Guarantor), representing the percentage of the Contract Price, specified in the Contract, and we undertake to pay you, upon your first written demand and without cavil or argument, any sum or sums within the limits of Nu/ INR _____ (Amount of Guarantee) as aforesaid without your needing to prove or to show grounds or reasons for your demand for the sum specified therein.

We hereby waive the necessity of your demanding the said debt from the Contractor before presenting us with the demand.

We further agree that no change or addition to or other modification of the terms of the Contract or of the Works to be performed there under or of any of the Contract documents which may be made between you and the Contractor shall in any way release us from any liability under this guarantee, and we hereby waive notice of any such change, addition or modification.

This guarantee is valid until the date of 30 days after expiry of the warranty period of the Equipment.

Pre-Contract Integrity Pact Statement.

This agreement should be a part of the tender document, which shall be signed and submitted along with the tender document. The head of the employing agency/or his authorized representative should be the signing authority. For the Bidders, the Bidder himself or his authorized representative must sign the Integrity Pact (IP).

1 General:

Whereas representing the Punatsangchhu-II Hydroelectric Project Authority, hereinafter referred to as the **“Employer”** on one part, and Mr./Mrs.....representing M/s....., hereinafter referred to as the **“Bidder”** on the other part hereby execute this agreement as follows:

This agreement shall be a part of the standard bidding document, which shall be signed by both parties at the time of purchase of bidding documents and submitted along with the tender document. This IP is applicable only to **“large”** scale works, goods, and services, the threshold of which will be announced by the government from time to time. The signing of the IP shall not apply to framework contracting such as annual office supplies etc.

2 Objectives:

Whereas, the Employer and the Bidder agree to enter into this agreement, hereinafter referred to as IP, to avoid all forms of corruption or deceptive practice by following a system that is fair, transparent, and free from any influence/unprejudiced dealings in the **bidding process**¹ and **contract administration**², with a view to:

- 2.1 Enabling the Employer to obtain the desired contract at a reasonable and competitive price in conformity to the defined specifications of the works or goods or services; and
- 2.2 Enabling bidders to abstain from bribing or any corrupt practice in order to secure the contract by providing assurance to them that their competitors will also refrain from bribing and other corrupt practices.

3. Scope:

The validity of this IP shall cover the bidding process and contract administration period.



4. Commitments of the Employer:

The Employer commits itself to the following: -

- 4.1 The Employer hereby undertakes that no officials of the Employer, connected directly or indirectly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or accept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favor, or any material, or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the Bidder, either for themselves or for any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for an advantage in the bidding process and contract administration.
- 4.2 The Employer further confirms that its officials shall not favor any prospective bidder in any form that could afford an undue advantage to that particular bidder in the bidding process and contract administration and will treat all Bidders alike.
- 4.3 Officials of the Employer, who may have observed or noticed or have reasonable suspicion shall report to the head of the employing agency or an appropriate government office any violation or attempted violation of clauses 4.1 and 4.2.
- 4.4 Following report on violation of clauses 4.1 and 4.2 by the official(s), through any source, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings shall be initiated by the Employer and such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to the bidding process and contract administration.

5. Commitments of Bidders

The Bidder commits himself/herself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means, and illegal activities during any stage of the bidding process and contract administration in order to secure the contract or in furtherance to secure it and in particular commits himself/herself to the following: -

- 5.1 The Bidder shall not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favor, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage, or inducement to any official of the Employer, connected directly or indirectly with the bidding process and contract administration, or to any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for any advantage in the bidding process and contract administration.
- 5.2 The Bidder shall not collude with other parties interested in the contract to manipulate in whatsoever form or manner, the bidding process and contract administration.
- 5.3 If the bidder(s) have observed or noticed or have reasonable suspicion that the provisions of the IP have been violated by the procuring agency or other bidders, the bidder shall report such violations to the head of the procuring agency.



6. Sanctions for Violation:

The breach of any of the aforesaid provisions shall result in administrative charges or penal actions as per the relevant rules and laws.

- 6.1 The breach of the IP or commission of any offense (forgery, providing false information, misrepresentation, providing false/fake documents, bid rigging, bid steering or coercion) by the Bidder, or anyone employed by him, or acting on his/her behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Bidder), shall be dealt with as per the terms and conditions of the contract and other provisions of the relevant laws, including Debarment Rules.
- 6.2 The breach of the IP or commission of any offense by the officials of the procuring agency shall be dealt with as per the rules and laws of the land in vogue.

7. Monitoring and Administration:

- 7.1 The respective procuring agency shall be responsible for the administration and monitoring of the IP as per the relevant laws.
- 7.2 The bidder shall have the right to appeal as per the arbitration mechanism contained in the relevant rules.

We, hereby declare that we have read and understood the clauses of this agreement and shall abide by it.
