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**Control and Prevention of spread of Corona virus (COVID19) in PHPA-II sites**

**STANDARD OPERATING PROCESS (SOP)**

1. Notify immediately JAL Hospital and BHU Kamechu in the event of any suspected case(s) in the worksites.
  - i. Dr. Deepak Tamang, JAL Hospital 77641864.
  - ii. Mr. Sonam Jamtsho, CO, BHU Kamechu 17668059.
2. Conduct rigorous awareness program on sanitation and personal hygiene stressing on hand washing in all sites and promote hand hygiene.
3. The concerned contractors to increase hand washing facilities at site and provide hand washing soaps at every hand washing points.
4. Sanitize buses transporting workers during the morning and evening shift before and after boarding. Other common places and facilities must also be sanitized every day.
5. Use checklist provided by Ministry of Health to check and monitor any suspected case and immediately report to Dzongkhag Health Officer (DHO # 77364050) and Chief Medical Officer (CMO # 17233078), Jatshokha Hospital Wangdue Dzongkhag for further necessary action.
6. Establish a separate clinic in Kamechu BHU in the event of increasing number of flu cases within the project area for proper screening of cases.
7. Separate quarantine spaces created in JAL(4rooms), GIL(11 rooms), Kamechu (4rooms) and Fire Station(6rooms) to be used in the event of any emergencies. The committee will check and report by 21<sup>st</sup> March 2020.
8. Strictly comply with Notification No.81/DHPS/HQ/NA/2019-20/91 dated 6 March 2020 of Director, DHPS and Tha(01)/2020/2136 dated 6 March 2020 of the Home Secretary. Movement of workers will be minimal even after lifting the current suspension of movement.
9. Sanitize office space and equipments on daily basis.
10. Monitor compliance to the instruction to ensure sanitation and hand hygiene are maintained on regular basis.
